

Resolution 2014-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH SHORES
AMENDING THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE FOR RULES OF PROCEDURE
FOR THE DAYTONA BEACH SHORES CITY COUNCIL; AND PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Daytona Beach Shores City Council, as the duly elected governing body for the City of Daytona Beach Shores holds regular scheduled public meetings to discuss, review and act upon items which affect the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.16 of the City Charter establishes that the Daytona Beach Shores City Council shall determine its own rules and order of business; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted an Administrative Code for rules to establish a method of conduct to govern all meetings of the Daytona Beach Shores City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend its Administrative Code as a result of Florida Statutes §286.0114 that went into effect October 1, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH SHORES, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Section 2-1.1 (d) Public Participation will be amended to state:

- (1) Public input shall be allowed from the audience prior to each formal vote of the City Council.
- (2) Public participation shall be governed by the following rules:
 - a. Except when limited pursuant to Florida Statutes §286.0114(3), members of the public have the reasonable opportunity to be heard at Regular Meetings on the agenda during (a) Audience Comments and (b) public comments held after agenda items have been discussed by the council.
 - b. The speaker may discuss any matter within the scope of the jurisdiction of the City Council.
 - c. Speakers wishing to address the City Council during the times set aside for public comment shall fill out a speaker form and will keep the presentation to three (3) minutes or less. One form per agenda item is required. The form will be used to inform the Mayor of a desire to be heard; to indicate an individual's support, opposition, or neutrality on an item.
 - d. Each person recognized shall step forward to the podium, and shall give his name and address in an audible tone for the record. All remarks shall be addressed to the City Council as a body and not to any member thereof. At no time may the speaker enter into a debate either directly or through a member of the City Council.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
