

**RESOLUTION 2014-11**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF DAYTONA BEACH SHORES, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE CANVASSING OF THE VOTES FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH SHORES HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2014; DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR; DECLARING THE RE-ELECTION OF TWO CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS WITHOUT OPPOSITION; DECLARING THE CITY SHALL BE THE JUDGE OF THE ELECTION SUBJECT TO REVIEW BY THE COURTS, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS, the candidates referenced in this Resolution have met the requirements for office of Mayor and Council Members in compliance with Sections 2.01 and 2.02 of the City Charter and other applicable provisions of the Municipal Charter and State Statutes; and**

**WHEREAS, the City Charter as adopted has established rules and regulations for the General Election of Municipal Officers; and**

**WHEREAS, a General Election for City Council was called for November 4, 2014;**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DAYTONA BEACH SHORES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION ONE: A General Election was held November 4, 2014 in the City of Daytona Beach Shores for the Office of Mayor.**

**SECTION TWO: The City Council hereby accepts that the Volusia County Canvassing Board has canvassed the votes cast for the General Election in accordance with Section 6.06 of the City Charter as follows:**
