

RESOLUTION 2015-04

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY ENCOURAGING THE VOLUSIA COUNTY COUNCIL TO ADOPT A FAIR, UNIFORM, COMPREHENSIVE AND ECONOMICALLY SOUND APPROACH TO BEACH DRIVING.

WHEREAS, Volusia's beach is the County's greatest environmental and economic asset; and

WHEREAS, any change in one segment of the beach may adversely affect multiple municipalities; and

WHEREAS, a piecemeal policy regarding removing cars from the beach has not proven to be economically successful; and

WHEREAS, it is not prudent on the County's part to co-mingle the removal of beach driving with multiple, unrelated issues such as homelessness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH SHORES, FLORIDA:

SECTION ONE: The City of Daytona Beach Shores strongly opposes a piecemeal approach to remove beach driving because such an approach will adversely affect other areas where driving continues to be permitted.

SECTION TWO: The City of Daytona Beach Shores strongly encourages the County to create off-beach parking in the immediate proximity to where no-drive zones are created or have been created.


SECTION THREE: The City of Daytona Beach Shores strongly encourages the County to exercise sound financial responsibility by purchasing less expensive derelict property on the west side of SRA1A in our City to develop parking lots, rather than purchasing much more valuable oceanfront property and, therefore, permanently removing some of the County's most valuable property from the tax rolls.

SECTION FOUR: The City of Daytona Beach Shores strongly encourages the County to develop a cost-effective approach toward the creation of off-beach parking prior to removing all beach driving.

SECTION FIVE. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




